President's Report - Andrew Maclay

- JC3: host preseason instructional clinics, preseason player evaluations, referees, etc. A. Maclay was speaking with them today regarding JC3 running 1st/2nd Clinics for the first six weeks (6 hours/session; approx 20-25 kids per session). A. Maclay will reach out to JC3 to get things rolling.

- Tryouts went well. Big thanks to the high school coaches Coach Maclay, Coach Brogan, Coach McGynn Coach Mein, and past board members / travel coaches Brian Toohey and Marc McCaffery for their evaluations. Parents and players will be notified by tonight, 10/22/18.
- 5th Grade Head Coach was selected: Sue Gordimer
- 5th, 6th, and 8th Grade teams will be B level teams; 7th Grade teams will be an A level team
- M. Johnson will need to order travel uniforms this year, as well.
- Lakeland paperwork is due at November 18 Lakeland meeting; mandatory for all travel coaches
- M. Johnson will be registering all teams for a Thanksgiving Tournament (5th, 6th, 8th at Randolph; 7th at Drew University); Early Bird payments due this week.

Head of Referees' Report- Jay Wordsman

- Refs are all set for the upcoming season.
- If the board would like J. Wordsman to attend any coaches meetings to speak about sportsmanship, etc, J. Wordsman is willing to attend if a) needed and b) available.
