President's Report - Andrew Maclay

- A. Maclay met with Jay Hersh of JC3 regarding needs for upcoming season. JC3 is a LLC company, officials are paid through the LLC company. No issues keeping them at \$30/game rate. J. Hersh can mix and match his officials (has cadet-level up to senior levels). Will keep games to an average of \$35/game. Within proposal there is a mentorship; J. Hersh will meet with our coaches to go over rules, etc at beginning of season. A. Maclay reached out to our officials to see who would be interested in coming back next year and working with JC3. Seven officials reached out they would like to come back; the rest responded that they were not interested. A. Maclay will reach out to the seven officials interested and give them JC3's info to get everything rolling. Proposal includes 5 clinics, assignment/oversight, average \$35/game, 1-2 coach's meeting, coach's clinic at \$4,250. C. Kleiven asked how official-training would occur as it is not included in the proposal. A. Maclay will reach out to J. Hersh. A. Maclay will reach out to B. Coward to see if the town would pay officials.
- Middle School basketball team is happening and will consist of a JV and Varsity team. R. Furman and B. Nolan met with administrators. Following that meeting, A. Maclay and M. Johnson met with R. Furman and B. Nolan to discuss the CMS teams and major concern is top-level players get drafted, then choose to play for CMS team and leave rec. Then what happens to the team that the player was drafted to? We'll have to keep all this in mind moving forward during try-outs and drafts.
