

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. When is registration and how do I register?

- Registration is only done online at <http://tysl.info/>
- A signed Heads Up Concussion Form must be submitted to the office, but no other forms or documentation are required.
- Early registration is recommended to ensure placement on a team and a \$10 discount is offered during early registration.
- Spring registration opens October 1st
- Fall registration opens in May 1st.

Q 2. Do I have to live in Troy to register?

- No. We welcome players from all communities.

Q 3. Do you have programs for 3 or 4-year-olds?

- Yes! We offer a program for kids under 5 that is once per week on Saturday mornings at Jaycee Park.
- It is non-competitive and focused on socialization, fun and skills.
- Only equipment required is a size 3 ball and shin guards.

Q 4. Do you have programs for high school players?

- Yes! Games are only on weekends and players will play teams from other nearby communities.
- Scrimmage jersey is provided.
- They must have shin guards covered by socks and cleats.

Q 5. What equipment will I need?

- Players in grades K-8 will need a uniform kit which is sold in the office for \$50.
- The kit consists of two jerseys (home/red & away/blue), shorts, socks and bag for your gear.
- The uniform does not need to be purchased each season because you can use the uniform until your child outgrows it. Plan on room to grow when you purchase!
- They must have shin guards covered by socks and cleats. A water bottle and personal practice soccer ball are recommended.
- Scrimmage jerseys are provided for Pre-K and High school players.

Q 6. What size soccer ball do I purchase?

- Pre-K through 2nd grade: size 3
- 3rd grade through 6th grade: size 4
- 7th and up: size 5

Q 7. Do you have indoor soccer?

- No, TYSL only offers outdoor soccer during the fall and spring.

Q 8. Where are games played?

- Kindergarten through grade 2, games are always played at Jaycee Park located on Long Lake near John R.
- Grades 3-High School will play at Firefighters Park located on Square Lake between Crooks and Coolidge.

Q 9. What is the cost of your programs?

- Pre-K: \$60
- K-8: early registration is \$90, regular registration is \$110, late registration is \$145
- Co-ed High School: \$60

Q 10. How are teams formed? Will my child play with the school team?

- TYSL does not have **school** teams.
- We place players according to your address and in order of registration.
- Late registration may result in being placed on a wait list, and then, if available, possibly a team outside of your neighborhood.
- Teams are generally kept the same from the fall to the spring, but your player may not remain on the same team if you register late or if teams are combined.
- In the fall teams are reformed so you may not be with the same coach or team in the fall.

Q 11. Can I request a team or coach?

- No, TYSL does not accept requests for a specific coach or team.
- You can indicate if there is a coach you do **NOT** want when you register for the season.

Q 12. What is the schedule?

- Our K to 8th grade season generally consists of ten games over approximately 5 weeks in spring and 9 weeks in fall.
- You may play up to two games a week, one weeknight and one weekend game.
- Typically, boys play Saturdays & girls play Sunday(afternoons).
- Coaches schedule the practices.
- We cannot tell you which day during the week your child will play until schedules are released close to the start of the season.
- Use the "SI Play" app once you are contacted by your coach to keep on top the schedule.

Q 13. How do I know if games or practices are cancelled due to weather?

- Games will generally be cancelled for severe weather or unplayable field conditions.
- Except for Pre-K, rain or snow will not result in cancellation.
- Schedule changes should be communicated by your coach and updated to the "SI Play" app.
- TYSL will post cancellations on the website (tysl.info).

Q 14. Can I get a refund?

- Refunds are offered up until the start of the season minus a \$20 administrative fee.
- Late registration fees are not refunded.
- If you chose to receive an account credit rather than a refund you will not be assessed the \$20 administrative fee.
- Account credits can be applied to any child on your account.
- No refunds are offered after the games have started.
