Pre-K Soccer Program

The purpose of our Pre-K program is to “Have fun for the players, parents and grandparent”. Next is socialization and learning to be part of a team. Lastly, physical activities and to learn some soccer skills and to play the game of soccer. The atmosphere is structured, but informal.

When: Spring and Fall Soccer Seasons

Time: 9:00am Saturday mornings with potential for 10:30 am session

How Long: Six one hour sessions each season

Equipment: Shin guards, athletic or cleated shoes, soccer ball (#3), and bottle of water.

Scrimmage Jersey provided.



Kindergarten thru Eighth Grade Soccer Program

Our Kindergarten thru 8th grader soccer program is recreational level soccer. Players learn soccer ball handling skills, rules of the game and how to work as a team. Games are played during the week and on weekends with practice scheduled by individual team coaches.

No prior soccer experience is needed to play.

Coaches are parent volunteers. Each season there is a coaches’ orientation.

The league offers coaching clinics.

Required Equipment: Jersey, shorts, shin guards, socks, athletic/soccer shoes (rubber cleats preferred), soccer ball (check for appropriate size), and water bottle.

Length of Game , field size, and number of players is age group determined.



Co-ed High School Soccer Program

An 11 v11 format for high school players who are **not** playing high school or travel soccer in current season.

Most games are played late Sunday afternoons with occasional Saturday afternoon games. Games are scheduled against local leagues as well as teams from Clarkston, Madison Heights, Rochester, Romeo, Royal Oak, and West Bloomfield. Game scores are kept and this division post standings.

Three Referees: Center Referee & two Assistant Referees.

Length of Game: Two 40-minute halves with a 5-minute break.

Cost \$60 for each season of 8 games. No late fee.

Scrimmage Jersey provided.
