Hudson Kiwanis Travel Basketball

Hudson Kiwanis Travel basketball requires a commitment to attend all practices and games throughout the season. Competitive league play on weekend days, as well as tournaments over the course of weekend days is mandatory. A typical week will consist of 2 practices (sometimes 3) during weeknights with 1-2 league games per weekend. Tournament play begins February and runs through March with a minimum of 3 games per weekend which require travel from 5-50 miles. Playing time is fair and balanced according to league rules, Kiwanis guidelines and child development.

Hudson Kiwanis Travel basketball requires participants to try out for a team. Your child **MUST** attend both try out sessions. You must sign up with HCER to be eligible to try out for travel basketball. There is an additional cost of \$210 to participate in travel basketball which covers uniforms, shooting shirt, league play, and tournament fees. This fee is payable immediately upon selection of team.
