Tie Breakers for Pool Play to determine seeds for the championship game:

- 1. Overall record in the two preliminary games
- 2. Head to Head winner
- 3. For three team ties, the highest total cumulative run spread over the three games will determine the order of finish, with a maximum of 10 run differential per game. For example: If team A beats team B b team A is credited with +10 runs, team A is credited with +10 and team B is credited with -10.

Note: If there is a two-way tie for point differential for first among the teams tied with the top pool record, then the head to head winner of those two is ranked first and the head to head loser is ranked secon If there is a two-way tie for point differential for second among the teams tied with the top pool record, the head to head winner is ranked second. If there is a three way tie, continue to step 4.

- 4. Fewest total cumulative runs allowed over the three games. Note: If there is a two-way tie for runs allowed for first among the teams tied with the top pool record, then the head to head winner of those tw ranked first and the head to head loser is ranked second. If there is a two-way tie for runs allowed for second among the teams tied with the top pool record, the head to head winner is ranked second.

 If there is a three-way tie, continue to step 5.
