

Playing at AYHA Rinks

- All players, coaches, managers and spectators must complete the AYHA Covid-19 Protocol the first time they play at an AYHA affiliated rink. The link can be found on AYHA home page- www.adkhockey.com
Completion of the form acknowledges acceptance of the terms and only needs to be completed one time.
- All players, coaches, managers and spectators must complete the AYHA Contact Tracing and Covid Screening before every AYHA game they participate in. The link can be found on the AYHA home page www.adkhockey.com under the title AYHA Contact Tracing and Covid Screening. This form must be completed for every AYHA game that is participated in.
- Coaches/managers should provide the home coach/manager with a roster beforehand preferably via email to expedite check in.

PLAYERS AND COACHES

- No off ice warm ups will be allowed in AYHA facilities.
- Masks must be worn at **ALL** (on and off ice) times when in AYHA facilities. Special care should be taken when utilizing benches. Masks must be worn properly, covering both nose and mouth.
- Players must enter the rink fully dressed with the exception of gloves, helmets and skates. Small bags will be permitted. Goalies are the only exception and may use large hockey bags and dress inside.
- Water bottles should be labeled and filled before arrival. Bottle fillers are not available at either AYHA affiliated facility.
- No admittance into AYHA facilities until 10 minutes before scheduled ice time. When possible please remain in vehicles to avoid congregating.
- Visiting teams will utilize the area behind the visitor's bench at the **Glens Falls Rec Center** to put on skates. The home team will use the area behind the home bench. Enter the **Cool Insuring Arena** through the doors on Oakland Ave. Visiting teams will use the hallway to the right and the home team will use the hallway straight ahead.
- Stick taps with each team on their respective blue lines will replace handshakes when time allows.
- Players should exit the ice promptly, remove gloves, helmets and skates and promptly leave the building. This time must be limited to 10 minutes or less. **Cool Insuring Arena**-Please follow arrows on the floor to exit onto Glen St. Oakland Ave will be to your left when exiting the building.
- Please pay attention to signs regarding physical distancing, no loitering, entrance and exit.

SPECTATORS

- No admittance into AYHA facilities until 10 minutes before scheduled ice time. Spectators should be respectful of players and allow them to enter and check in first.
- One (1) spectator is allowed per player. Spectators must check in and should have already completed the AYHA Contact Tracing and COVID Screening.
- Masks must be worn at ALL times when in AYHA facilities. Mask must be worn properly, covering both nose and mouth.

- A distance of at least 6 feet should be maintained among spectators. Spectators to the **Cool Insuring Arena** may sit in **Section C (Home)** or **K (away)** and maintain a physical distance of 6 feet.
- Spectators should exit facilities upon the completion of the game. **Cool Insuring Arena**-Please follow arrows on the floor to exit onto Glen St. Oakland Ave will be to your left when exiting the building.
- Please pay attention to signs regarding physical distancing, no loitering, entrance and exit.
