- High School senior attending college in the 2017 Fall Semester
- Must have a current Youth Target Foundation Membership and must be on a current Youth Target Foundation team.
- Have gone out of their way to serve others
- Must have shown outstanding citizenship.
- Must have completed all of their YTF service hours for the current year.
- Was helpful, polite, and kind to other team members.
- Went the extra mile to help.
- Showed good sportsmanship.
- Was polite to coaches and was willing to take advice and listen to those around him/her.
- Was respectful to all leaders, including those outside of their team, and to referees, scorers, pullers, and those working at the ranges.
