Snackbar Team Shift Information

- 4 parent volunteers must staff the snack bar at all times 3 inside the snack bar, 1 at the BBQ
- Due to limited work space, children are not allowed in the snack bar
- Parent volunteers help with the set up of the snack bar at the start of the shift and help with cleanup at closing.
- Youth volunteers working for community service hours may only work stocking the snack bar or helping with field setup. Since they are too young to handle food or money, we are limited to what they can help with.
- Parent volunteers should check in with a board member at the start of their scheduled shift.
- BUYOUTS are available. A buyout is when the parents of a team pay workers to work for them in the snack bar. I have about 5-6 people that are available to work. I am simply work as a "go between" and pass on the cash to them BUT I also make sure someone shows up to work the shift.
 - •Please email ME at <u>Ksteinmuller@ocll.com</u> at least 2 <u>WEEKS prior to your scheduled shift to let me know you</u> <u>will need a buyout</u>. The buyout cost is \$10 per hour per person.
 - Example If you have a 4 hour shift the total team buyout cost = \$160. Here's the breakdown: 4 people x \$10 x 4 hr shift = \$160, payable in cash only. The buyout cost will change if a parent chooses to work, while others buyout.
 - IF PARENTS WANT TO WORK A SNACKBAR SHIFT,
 THE MINIMUM HOURS THEY MUST WORK IS 2. IT'S
 NOT FAIR TO PAY A BUYOUT WORKER LESS THEN THIS.

NOTE: All volunteers must be at least 18 years of age to work in the snack bar and NO CHECKS are accepted from parents for buyout. CASH ONLY

CASH is due at least 1 WEEK before the start of your snack bar shift in a sealed envelope, labeled with your team name & division, the snack bar date and time and the # of buyouts needed.

IF A TEAM FAILS TO FOLLOW THE TIMELINES ABOVE, WE WILL BE FORCED TO STAFF THE SHIFT WITH BUYOUT WORKERS AND YOUR MANAGER WILL BE SUSPENDED FOR (1) GAME
