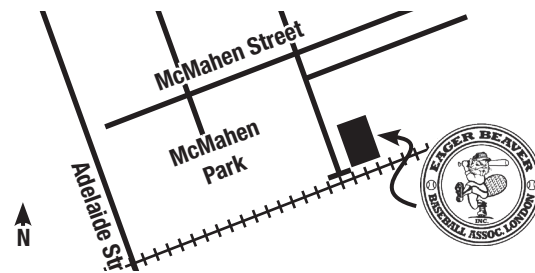

### Information

- EBBA is London's longest running youth sports program.
- EBBA offers house league baseball to players ages 4-21.
- EBBA is fully volunteer run and cannot succeed without full support of players and parents.
- Players are placed in divisions based on the age they are turning this year.
- Baseball is a team sport and parents and players are reminded that by signing up they are making a commitment to a team and accordingly must plan to attend all scheduled practices and games.
- Requests for refunds must be made by email by March 31 and are subject to a \$15 administration fee.

### Divisions

All registration fees include a mandatory \$50 fundraising fee (only \$10 for Little Sluggers and \$20 for Tball) plus a \$15 park improvement fee.

#### Little Sluggers

Born in 2014 & 2015 \$65.00

All sessions at Mornington Park

- 5 one hour sessions on Saturday mornings running May 25 to June 22
- 3 time slots – 9:00 am, 10:15 am & 11:30 am. New players placed in the first 2 sessions and returning players placed in the 11:30 session unless otherwise requested and as space permits
- Baseball skills are introduced at practice stations with emphasis on learning while having fun!

#### T-Ball

Born in 2012 & 2013 \$115.00

All sessions at Mornington Park

- 9 one and a half hour sessions on Saturday mornings running from May 11 to July 13
- 2 time slots – 9:00 am & 10:30 am with new players placed at 9:00 am and returning players placed at 10:30 am unless otherwise requested and as space permits.
- Players are placed on teams of 8 players. Teams rotate through practice stations for half the session and play a scrimmage for the other half. Emphasis is placed on learning baseball skills and utilizing them in game situations.
- Parent participation is crucial to the success of the program.
- Final session (July 13) is held at Labatt Park for the Colman Day celebrations.

All games at Mornington Park

- There are 18 90-105 minute games in the regular season followed by double elimination playoffs. There are 2 games and 1 practice each week.
- Team practices start the beginning of May with games starting after May 20. Playoffs begin in August. Weeknight game time is 6pm. Players should be at the field ½ hour before game time. Most games are weeknights however there will be games Saturday, June 1 for Opening Day/Picture Day. Most practices are on the weekend.
- Rookie - Pitching machines are used and leadoffs and stealing are not allowed.
- Rookie - Experienced players born in 2012 may evaluate to play up in the Rookie division.
- Mosquito – Players learn to pitch and learn basic base running skills. The position of catcher is developed.
- There are preseason conditioning clinics starting in January free of charge to registered players. Mondays - Rookies, Tuesdays - Mosquitoes. See website for locations and details.

- Team practices start in May with games usually starting after May 20. Playoffs begin in August. Weeknight game time is 8pm. Players should be at the field ½ hour before game time. Most games are weeknights however there may be occasional games on the weekend. Most practices are on the weekend.
- Wood bats are the only bats allowed in this league.
- Players born in 1997 can play as overagers but cannot pitch or catch. Other restrictions may apply.
