

## FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions)

### 1) How do I become a Recreation and Park Volunteer?

- First step is finding a program you are interested in.
- Visit your local Recreation Center and see what programs are available
- Or Go online and find classes you would like to support
- You must have found a class or program and spoken to your supervisor setting up a fingerprinting appointment

### 2) How do I find an Application?

### 3) Why do I need a background Check?

It is a State Law that all volunteers supervising sensitive populations such as youth and senior programs pass a background clearance with the Department of Justice in Sacramento.

- Tuesday - 3:00 to 4:15pm
  - Thursday - 3:30 to 4:45pm
  - Friday - 9:30 to 11:15am
- \*Appointments generally last 15-20 minutes (subject to change depending on the season)

- Gray building inscribed with "Park Emergency Hospital"
- Adjacent to Kezar Stadium parking lot
- Public entrance is on the north side of the building

### 7) What to bring to your Fingerprinting Appointment?

- Bring a filled out application  
**and**
- A picture ID (i.e. California Drivers license, California ID, School ID, Government issued License/ ID, or Passport)
