

Lakeville Baseball Association Travel Tournament Rules - 2019

Tournament Manager

- Tournament manager does not have the ability to inform you of your playing times due to tournament size. Coaches are responsible to check the LBA website to verify playing times for both pool and brackets.
- Tournament manager has sole discretion on interpreting all rules and to make any decisions on issues/questions, not specifically outlined in these rules.

Tournament Registration

- Registration is done through the MBL website.
- Three games guaranteed - pool play with bracket format
- If the person registering is not going to be the coach, please make sure to email the team contact / coach information when it changes. All contact changes should be emailed to tournaments@lakevillebaseball.org
- No all star teams allowed.

Tournament Roster

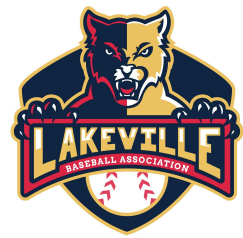
At tournament check in, the following must be presented:

1. Completed roster with player names, jersey number and birthdate. Roster document is on the website..
2. Birth certificates for each player
3. Concussion certificate & Safe Sports certificate for each coach or adult that will be in the dugout.

Any team with an incomplete roster shall be withheld from competition.

Key Tournament Rules

- Each team is responsible for providing one new baseball for each game.
- Teams may not warm up on the infield. Teams can hit ground balls down sidelines.
- [MBT rules](#) will be used for these tournaments.
- NEW BAT Rules: All 9U through 14U batters must use USA Stamped bats of -3 BBCOR bats.
- 15U batters may use BBCOR or wooden bats.
- Pitch counts will be enforced. Please see the pitch count limits in the tournament rules.



Tournament Refunds

- NO refunds will be made after confirmation has been sent unless we receive another paid registration. Refunds will be subject to a cancellation fee.
- Three games completed is considered a full tournament. If the tournament is shortened for any reason, your fee will be prorated based on the number of games completed and a refund sent.
- If the tournament has to be canceled due to unforeseen circumstances (i.e. weather, etc.) AND:
 - a. No games have been played teams will be refunded their entry fee less \$50. ☐
 - b. If a team has completed their first game, the entry fee minus \$150 will be refunded. ☐
 - c. If 2 or more games are completed no refund will be issued.
 - d. If a team drops out after the entry deadline, they will not receive a refund unless a replacement team is accepted.
- NO spots held without receipt of entry fee.
- NO checks returned in the event that the tournament is already full. Your check will be shredded.

Park/Field Rules

- Head coaches are responsible for the behavior of its players, coaches, and spectators.
- Violations will be brought to the attention of the head coach who is expected to resolve the situation immediately. Violation of park rules may result in forfeiting an out, forfeiting an inning, or forfeiting the game.
- Park rules include, but may not be limited to:
 - No drinking alcoholic beverages in the park, parking lot or surrounding city property
 - No smoking in the park
