BABE RUTH LEAGUE RULES

The league will play by Babe Ruth Rules and Regulations and Official Baseball Rule Book. Exceptions and additions are listed below:

1. Playing an ineligible player will result in forfeiture of the game.
2. If a team has less than ten players, up to two pool player (s) may be used. If a roster player arrives once the game has started, he/she must be inserted into the line-up in the last spot in the batting order. Pool player(s) continue to play if roster players arrive late. If a team has fewer than nine players, the ninth place in the batting order is recorded as an out each scheduled at bat. The game is a forfeit when a team is not able to field at least 8 players including the maximum of two pool players.
3. Babe Ruth pool player shall be any player in Senior League. A Senior Cub League player can only be used up to a 10-player roster.
4. Fully uniformed players, including socks are required; hats are required to be worn at all times by player while on the field; shirts are to be tucked-in at all times; and catcher must wear a cup-type supporter. Any player can be called out after one warning regarding uniform.
5. Players, coaches, managers, and bat boys are the only ones allowed in the dugout during a game.
6. The scorekeeper is to note the starting time of the game. This time is official.
7. All players must play a minimum of two innings with exception of injury or illness. Exception: Run rule or cancellation due to inclement weather. Additional exceptions to this rule may result in a forfeit for that game.
8. Free substitution rules will be used. Any player may be taken out and return to the game at the start of any half inning. All players will be placed in the batting order and bat in rotation throughout the game.
9. Warm-ups for pitchers: Seven (7) for new pitcher; five (5) for returning pitcher.
10. All games are scheduled for seven innings. A 10-run rule will be in effect after five complete innings. In case of rain, five innings is an official game (4 1/2 if home team is leading).
11. All players will be placed in the batting order and bat in rotation throughout the game.
12. The first game will start at 6:00 p.m.; the second game at 8:00 p.m. No innings shall start after the two-hour time limit. (Two hours and 15 minutes for single game nights)
13. A base runner must slide to avoid a collision. If a base runner deliberately runs into a fielder, the runner is out; i.e., a player who elects not to slide at home with intent of knocking the catcher over will be called out.
14. In the event of a tie game at the end of regulation, a maximum of two extra innings will be played. The last retired batter from the previous inning will be placed as a base runner at second base to begin the half-inning. Extra innings are played only if time remains under the time limit.
15. A point system will be used as tie breaker for league standings; three points for a win, one point for a tie, and 0 points for a loss. If canceled games are not rescheduled or an unequal number of games are played by all teams, then win/loss percentage will be used to determine league standings.
16. Awards will be given to the league champion, league runner-up, tourney champion and tourney runner-up.
17. All-Star managers and coaches will be selected by the league president. All-Star players shall be selected by appointed All-Star managers.
18. Pitchers will be allowed to pitch no more than seven innings in two consecutive games. Pitchers may not return to pitching after removal from the mound. If a pitcher delivers one pitch in an inning, the pitcher will be charged with a full inning. The second trip to the mound by a coach in the same inning to the same pitcher shall automatically result in the removal of that pitcher from the game as a pitcher only.
19. All make-up games will be played as scheduled and will be determined by the league president. Make-up games take precedent over practice schedules.
20. Play with infield fly rule. Balks will be called.
21. Any team that fails to perform duties (such as keeping scorebook, operating scoreboard, umpiring bases, raking areas, and trash clean-up from inside their dugout and bleacher areas) will play their next game using only two outs for the first three innings. Home team is responsible for official scorebook and field care after the game. Visiting team is responsible for the scoreboard.
22. Any player that fails to practice with his or her team on a regular basis may sit out their next game. This must be noted to the umpire before the game.
23. Ten minutes infield for each team will be allowed before the game. Coaches are responsible for starting infield on schedule and games will start on time even if infield must be stopped. Visitors take infield at 5:40 and 7:40. Home team takes infield at 5:50 and 7:50. If time permits, ten minutes will also be allowed for infield for the second game. No batting practice will be allowed after diamonds are lined for game.
24. Four outfielders may be used.
25. No practices are allowed on the diamond after it has been prepared for play prior to the game.
26. Any player who throws a helmet or bat will be warned once; the player will be ejected on the second offense.
27. Any player ejected from a game will not be eligible to play in the next game, and his eligibility is subject to review by the league president and vice president, with specific focus on the severity of the offense.
