JUNIOR ROOKIE CUB LEAGUE RULES

The league will play by Babe Ruth Cal Ripken Rules/Regulations and Official Baseball Rule Book. Exceptions and additions are listed below:

1. Playing an ineligible player will result in forfeiture of the game.
2. Ten minutes will be allowed for a team to field the required number of players; i.e., 6:10 p.m. and 8:10 p.m.
3. If a team has less than ten players, up to two pool player (s) may be used. If a roster player arrives once the game has started, he/she must be inserted into the line-up in the last spot in the batting order. Pool player(s) continue to play if roster players arrive late. If a team has fewer than eight players, the eighth place in the batting order (and any additional open places in the batting order thru the number 8 spot) is recorded as an out each scheduled at bat. The game is not a forfeit for failure to have enough players.
4. Rookie Cub pool player shall be any player in T-ball League. A T-ball Cub League player can only be used up to a 10-player roster.
5. Fully uniformed players are required; i.e., hats are required to be worn at all times by players in the field.
6. Players, coaches, managers, and batboys are the only ones allowed in the dugout during a game. Only one defensive coach allowed on the field per team during the game.
7. The scorekeeper is to note the starting time of the game. This time is official. Home team is responsible for official scorebook and scoreboard. Visiting team on first base side and responsible to put bases and pitching machine away after last game. Umpiring responsibilities are indicated on schedule. Two umpires are preferred, one is mandatory.
8. All players are in the batting order and play in the field. Only six infielders including the catcher (all others must play outfield). Only one infielder stationed at pitching machine and must play behind the line.
9. Batter gets three strikes or five pitches, unless last pitch is a foul ball.
10. No stealing. Runner cannot leave base until batter hits the ball.
11. All games are scheduled for six innings. A 15-run rule will be in effect after four complete innings. A team may score a maximum of 5 runs per inning, except last inning. In case of rain, four innings is an official game (3½ if home team is leading).
12. The pitching machine will be set 40 feet from home plate and will have the power pedal set to 4, which correlates to 30 MPH. Coaches shall pitch to their own team. Machine may be adjusted at any time.
13. No innings shall start after the two-hour time limit.
14. A base runner must slide to avoid a collision. If a base runner deliberately runs into a fielder, the runner is out; player who elects not to slide at home with the intent of knocking the catcher over will be called out.
15. In the event of a tie game at the end of regulation, extra innings will be played if the game is still within the two-hour time limit. After the time limit, the game is recorded as a tie. If the game affects league standings, the game will be played as a new game at the end of the regular season.
16. Tiebreaker for first place in league standings is a one-game playoff. If more than two teams are involved, a coin flip will be used to determine playoff game sequence (single elimination).
17. Awards will be given to the league champion, league runner-up, tourney champion, and tourney runner-up.
18. The league president will select post-season managers and coaches. Post-season players shall be selected by appointed Post-season managers.
19. Once an infield player has control of the ball in the circle of the infield in fair territory, and no attempt is made on a runner, the ball is dead if the defensive player with the ball calls a time out. The runners then advance to the next base if they have both feet completely across the line. If play is made on a runner, all runners may advance at risk. Umpires discretion is final.
20. Special base-running rule: One warning per team for base running violations (leaving base early), any runner is out on the second violation. Each successive violation by that team for the remainder of the game will result in an out.
21. All make-up games will be played as scheduled and will be determined by the league president. Make-up games take precedent over practice schedules.
22. No infield fly rule.
23. Any team that fails to perform duties (such as keeping scorebook, operating scoreboard, umpiring bases, raking areas, and trash clean up from inside their dugout and bleacher areas) will play their next game using only two outs for the first three innings.
24. Any player that fails to practice with his or her team on a regular basis may sit out their next game. This must be noted to the umpire before the game.
25. Ten minutes infield for each team will be allowed before the game. Coaches are responsible for starting infield on schedule and games will start on time even if infield must be stopped. Visitors take infield at 5:40 and 7:40. Home team takes infield at 5:50 and 7:50. If time permits, ten minutes will also be allowed for infield for the second game. No batting practice will be allowed after diamonds are lined for game.
26. No bunting. An attempted bunt is ruled a strike.
27. No practices are allowed on the diamond after it has been prepared for play prior to the game.
28. A batted ball that hits the pitching machine is a dead ball; runners advance one base whether forced or not.
