

# HVYS BASEBALL



ALL skills evaluations are held at our fields behind Moore High School, located at 6415 Outer Loop.

*Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your tryout time*

**DRAFTS/TEAM ASSIGNMENTS:** This process will begin on Monday 3/4, and there are 5 divisions to be drafted. We will post a spreadsheet on our website [www.highviewyouthsports.com](http://www.highviewyouthsports.com), after each draft, with your child's name, team name, coach's name and number. If you do not have this information by Saturday, 3/9, feel free to give us a call.

**PRACTICES:** Practices will begin on or around Monday, 3/11, but this may vary depending on your coach. Each team is allocated one practice during the week, and one on the weekend if available. Practices could be Monday thru Friday anytime 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm. We try to get the earlier practice times to the younger teams. It is our intention to get each team as much extra practice times. League assigned practices will be at the Highview behind Moore High School, however, your coach may be fortunate enough to be able to obtain additional practice areas and times away from Highview. It is your coach's responsibility to keep you informed of all team activities, so it is imperative that you BOTH know how to get in contact with one another. Please have your player bring a container of water with them to practice and to each game. It is also important that your player makes as many practices as possible. If you MUST miss a practice, PLEASE, notify your coach. Players who miss practice without a reasonable excuse are subject losing their eligibility for the next game; this is coach's discretion.

**OPENING DAY:** Saturday, April 20th

We have numerous opening day events such as helmet painting, games, bouncies, & basket raffles, more details to follow

**GAMES:** We try to schedule as many games as possible in each division, but it depends on the amount of teams in the division. Total games could range from 12-16. Our normal days of play are but NOT limited to Mondays-Tuesdays-Thursdays-Fridays& Saturdays. Our goal is to schedule one game per team during the week, and one on Saturday, OR two games during the

week, and none on Saturday, however, sometimes this is difficult to schedule in this manner. Highview reserves the, right to add, delete, reschedule, or move games as they seem necessary. We do our best to get game schedules out asap, but no later than one week prior to your first game.

**UNIFORMS:** Each player will be issued a practice t-shirt, game jersey, and game hat to keep, and MUST play each game in that uniform. Once players are placed on teams, the coach will inform you of what color pants (and possibly belt & socks) to purchase. All players need to be in full uniform to play. No uniform shall be altered in any way. We do the best we can to get uniforms out to the players asap, however, no later than one week prior to your first game.

**COMMUNICATIONS:** This is a key ingredient in running a good league, as well as you and your child enjoying the season. However, EVERYONE, including parents, need to communicate with one another as best as possible. BE SURE to get your team name, Coach's name AND phone number upon your first meeting. You, as a parent should also MAKE 100% CERTAIN that the coach has the best contact information for you, as well as the best method, i.e. phone call, text, e-mail, etc. We are working on a new system through Sports Illustrated and will get that information out to each of you as soon as it is completed. If you need to get in touch with a league official, our number is listed on this page, and we can also be reached through social media. You should send us a friend request on Facebook, OR, you can find a lot of pertinent information on SI Play.

**FOOD/DRINKS/COOLERS:** None are allowed to be brought into our baseball facility while games are being played. This include team coolers for your team. If you want to give out snacks/drinks for each player after your game, please go to the other side of the parking lot into the grass. Our concession stand is open during games and provides ample food and drinks for everyone. It is a vital source of income for our league. Please do you share in keeping our facility clean but putting your trash in cans around the park. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on school property.

**PARKING:** Parking is a MAJOR problem each season. Please park in designated parking spots with lines. Parking along the sides, fire lanes, by the bus compound, is prohibited.

**FUNDRAISER:** Each season we run a fundraiser to raise funds for an end of season party/banquet for everyone. It is imperative for everyone to participate in this fundraiser to assure a very entertaining party.

**CODE OF ETHICS:** ALL players, coaches, parents and fans are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful, adult manner. No vulgar language, yelling at the officials or any

unsportsmanlike actions will be tolerated. If you cannot follow these guidelines you are subject to be ejected from the facility. If so, you **MUST LEAVE THE PREMISES IMMEDIATELY**, and consideration of return to the next game will solely depend on league officials.

We feel we are the best league around, and after your participation, we are confident that you and your family will feel the same. However, there always seems to be a lack of people willing to volunteer their time, but never a lack of criticism. Please keep in mind that Highview Youth Sports is ran by unpaid volunteers, who volunteer their time away from their families to assure your child will have a place to play sports. We are ALWAYS looking for suggestions on ways to improve our league as well as willing volunteers.
