

Illinois District 13 Little League

2018 Minor A Softball Supplemental Rules

League Composition

- The Minor A Division in Illinois District 13 is comprised of league age 8-10 year olds who are either new to softball and Little League or only have a year or two of experience.
 - If a family requests that a league age 11 or 12 year old play down in the Minor A Division due to safety concerns they can sign the Little League Document and have their league age 11 or 12 year old play down with the League's Approval. Any league age 11 or 12 year old that plays in Minor A via an approved waiver may *NOT* pitch. A league age 11 or 12 year old that plays at this level will *NOT* be eligible for Majors Allstars.
- The Minor A Division will be scheduled to play a total of 16 games.
- Games will be scheduled on Tues, Thurs, Sat.
- Games to start Week of **4/30**.
- Deadline for Games to be played and entered in Admin site will be 6/23.
- At the end of the regular season all Minor A teams will be entered into a single elimination the Minor A Division Metro Tournament of Champions. Since all teams will be allowed to participate the season standings by points will be used for the team seeding and pairings for the initial round of games in the tournament. For example, the top seed would play the lowest seed team, etc.
 - Teams will be ranked through the season using a points system
 - Wins - 3 Points
 - Loss - 1 Point
 - Ties - 1 Point
 - Other - There will be a **15 minute** grace period, from the official scheduled start of the game for a team to field enough players. If **after** 15 minutes a team still does not have at least 8 players present that team will be issued zero (0) points. A point (1) will be assigned to the team that had 8 or more players present.
 - If a game isn't played due to the above circumstances and points are awarded, the score that will be input into the League Admin site will be 6-0
 - If there is a tie at the end of the season in points, the first tiebreaker will be head to head, second **total** runs allowed.
 - District will **NOT** issue any forfeits at any time, regardless of circumstance.

Administration

- Illinois District 13 Staff will be the overall administrators of the District 13 Minor A Division.
 - Each League will be responsible for their own teams, managers, coaches, fields, etc. as they are all chartering at the league level.
- Illinois District 13 will serve as the protest committee for District 13 Softball. The District will act on all protests within 72 hours of notification that are presented in accordance with article 4.19 of the Little League International Official Playing Rules (Orange Book).
 - All decisions made by District 13 in regards to protests will be considered final and binding.
- All standings will be kept on the District 13 Softball League Admin Pro website..

Umpires

- The home team is responsible for umpires for their games.
- ***An umpire is required on the field for all games***
- In the Minor A Division many leagues use volunteer umpires or adolescents that are learning how to be umpires. If the umpire is under the age of 18, there must be an adult in charge that is there to support the youth umpire. This adult does not have to be on the field but must be present at the game so that they may act in the young umpire's defense if needed.

Playing Rules

- The Little League Softball Rulebook (Orange Book) will be used for the Minor A Division in all areas except when explicitly stated within this document.
- Below are amendments that will apply during the ***regular season only***.
- Reschedules where the original game day was prior to June 1st but rescheduled to after June 1st, will be played with the Post June 1st Rules. The Rules will apply that are being used on the date the game is being played.

Time Limits

- The time limit for this division will be ***1 hour 45 minutes***. Once the game time has reached 1 hour 45 minutes, the umpire will make the announcement that the batter is the last one up. Metro Tournament semi finals and finals will not have a time limit.
 - If the visiting team is ahead and the home team hasn't completed their at-bat, then the current batter from the home team can complete their at-bat,

- however the final score for the game would revert back to the score at the end of the last completed inning.
- If the home team is ahead and batting, the final batter would finish their at-bat and the final score of the game would be score from the final play of their at-bat. For example if they hit a single and a runner scores, the final score of the game would include that run scored.
 - The time limit will begin with the coaches meeting at home plate with the umpire in chief and the specific time will be agreed upon during that meeting.
- In this division a game may start with less than 9 players, but no less than 8 players, for a specific team present at the game.
 - There will be a **15 minute** grace period, from the official scheduled start of the game for a team to field enough players. If **after** 15 minutes a team still does not have at least 8 players present that team will be issued zero (0) points. A point (1) will be assigned to the team that had 8 or more players present.
 - This is an instructional level, if a team wishes to “donate” a player to the opposing team so that they may have 9 to start the game it will be allowed.
 - There is no Slaughter Rule for this division.
 - This is a maximum of 5 runs scored per inning allowed.
 - In the event of inclement weather the opposing team must provide at least 1 hour 30 minute notification of the game’s cancellation.
 - This timeframe minimizes the negative impact of having to travel without playing a game.
 - A Double Safety First Base will be used at this division.
 - The Mandatory Play Rule will be **strictly** adhered to in accordance with Regulation IV (I) of the Little League Softball Rulebook (Orange Book).
 - A team’s official batting order, including names and numbers, must be provided to the opposing team at the manager’s’ meeting at home plate.
 - **Bunting and Stealing of Home are allowed AFTER 5/28.**
 - There is NOT a Dropped 3rd Strike Rule, i.e. if a catcher catches or doesn’t catch the 3rd strike, the batter is out.
 - Only 1 extra base may be taken on an overthrow on a live play from a batted ball or on a stolen base attempt.
 - The Minor A Division will be using a continuous batting order.
 - Minimum play is met when a player plays 6 defensive outs and 1 at bat.
 - The outs do NOT need to be continuous.

- Batting order for both teams will consist of the team with the most number of players at the game.
 - *If one team has 9 and the other team has 11, then 11 players will be considered as once through the order and the order stays as continuous.*
- An offensive inning will consist of batting 5 runs **or** three (3) outs, whichever occurs first.
- Minor A will use neon yellow 11 inch softballs, plush softballs are not allowed.

Pitching Rules - Prior to May 28, 2018

The Minor A Division is a Player & Coach Pitch Division prior to May 28, 2018.

- Once a batter reaches a count that includes 4 Balls, they will be replaced with a coach pitcher for the remainder of that batter's at bat.
- The coach will get 3 total pitches to the batter, if after those 3 pitches the batter does not put the ball in play, the batter is out.
 - Coach pitches that are fouled off by the batter DO NOT count in the 3 total pitches from the coach. For example, if 1 pitch is a strike and the batter fouls off 2 more pitches then the batter would still be allowed up to 2 more coach pitches.
 - **No walks** are allowed as a result of player or coach pitch.
- If a batter is hit by a pitch they will get the option of taking their base or continuing their at bat with the coach pitch rules of 3 pitches.
- Coaches must pitch underhand to batters.
- After the at-bat is completed, the player pitcher would replace the coach pitcher for the new hitter.
- If a pitcher hits three (3) batters in an inning, they must be replaced with a new player pitcher.
- The Coach will pitch from 35 feet, the required distance for the Minor Divisions in Little League Softball.
 - Soft-Toss and / or pitching from a closer distance is NOT allowed at any time.
- While the coach is pitching the player / pitcher must remain within the 8 foot circle and be even with, or behind, the coach that is pitching.
- Managers and coaches are *NOT* allowed to warm up pitchers at any time.

Pitching Rules - On & After May 28, 2018

- The Minor A Division will follow the Little League Rulebook (Orange Book) in regards to pitching and will no longer be a Coach Pitch League.
- Managers and coaches are *NOT* allowed to warm up pitchers at any time.

Pitching and Game Logs

- It is a **requirement** that managers for each team log their game scores within the League Admin Pro site.

- Managers are required to input their pitching information into the League Admin Pro website within **24 hours** of the game's conclusion.
 - Managers that become repeat offenders for not complying and not using the website, the following will be strongly suggested:
 - 1st Occurrence - Manager will receive a written warning
 - 2nd Occurrence - Manager will receive a one (1) game suspension
 - 3rd Occurrence - Manager will be suspended for five (5) games
 - 4th Occurrence - Manager will be removed for the remainder of the season
 - ***Please note that if a team hasn't uploaded their pitching information into the League Admin Pro website, pitches a player, and that player is found to be an ineligible pitcher, Little League Rules and Regulations will be followed in regards to ineligible pitchers.***

Game Rescheduling

- No game will be rescheduled for any reason except rainouts or a school event. or inability to field less than 8 players. **All Games will be rescheduled within 48 hours of the original game date.**
 - Once a makeup game is rescheduled the **VP or Rep** of the **HOME** team will make the appropriate changes to the time and date in the League Admin Pro program.

Good Sportsmanship

- Teams may cheer or chant for their **OWN** team only.
- **NO inappropriate** comments will be made towards the opposing team.
- **If inappropriate comments are made to an opposing team, the manager will receive a warning from the umpires. If the comments continue, the manager will be ejected from the game. This is subject to the Umpires' Discretion.**
