

## MYB 2020 OTIS RULES – PHASE 3

**THESE ARE NOT GUIDELINES OR SUGGESTIONS, BUT REQUIREMENTS FROM THE STATE AND TOWN THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED FOR PHASE 3. IF NOT FOLLOWED OTIS WILL BE CLOSED.**

### GENERAL

1. To participate or attend, players, coaches, volunteers and spectators must show no signs or symptoms of COVID-19 for 14 days. No persons in high risk categories should participate or attend activities.
2. If any individual develops symptoms of COVID-19 during activities, they should promptly notify MYB and be removed from activities.
3. The bathrooms and concession stand will **NOT** be open for Phase 3.
4. **ALL COACHES, VOLUNTEERS AND SPECTATORS MUST WEAR FACIAL COVERINGS. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
5. Players and coaches must achieve proper hand hygiene at the beginning and end of all practices.
6. Players and spectators should arrive at scheduled times and leave complex at conclusion of games. No congregating at fields or parking lots after conclusion of games.

### PLAYERS

1. Players must maintain 6ft of distance at all times. No high fives, fist bumps or other contact.
2. Players must wear face coverings while not on the field.
3. Batter must wear face coverings while at bat.
4. Baserunners and infielders who cannot maintain 6ft of distancing must wear face coverings.
5. No sharing of equipment (gloves, bats, helmets, etc.). MYB has a limited supply of helmets and bats which may be signed out for the duration of Phase 3.
6. Players must bring own drinks, no sharing. Please do not bring food.
7. No seeds, gum or any other food that encourages spitting allowed.
8. Dugouts will be closed. Players must keep their own equipment along base lines, 1 player per fence section.

### SPECTATORS

1. **SPECTATORS MUST WEAR FACIAL COVERINGS AND MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING OF 6FT AT ALL TIMES. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
2. **NO MORE THAN 2 SPECTATORS PER PLAYER. 50 SPECTATOR MAX PER FIELD.**
2. Spectators must be outside the fence, either in the outfield or behind home plate. Spectators are not allowed on bleachers.
