Race Format: Age groups will be U8, U10, U12, U14+

1. Slalom - two timed races - Awards for top 1-3 male and female each age group.
2. Gelande Jump - 2 practice jumps, 2 competition jumps - awards for top 1-3 male and female each age group for longest distance.
3. GS Dual Combined Male and Female - Racers will take one timed run on the red and the blue course. Combined time will place racers into an 8-person bracket. Top 8 will face off with a run on the red and the blue course, again best combined time wins with winner advancing to the next round. Awards for top 1-4 place.



4. Nordic- U8 ski one lap, U10 ski two laps, U12+ ski three laps. Awards for top 1-3 male and female each age group for best time.

**Each event will count for 25% towards the overall winner.
To be considered, racers must compete in all four events.**
