Intermediate

Intermediate Division Season Play

The Intermediate Division is intended to offer players an advanced level of competitive baseball, using the same rules as Juniors Division on a smaller, transitional field of 50-foot pitching distance, and 70-foot base distance. Players continue developing baseball fundamentals, all aspects of teamwork, and learn more advanced defense and offense strategy and skills in this competitive division more closely following “real baseball” rules. Although competitive, the focus remains on player development with the emphasis always placed on having fun, player safety, and sportsmanship!

1. All games including interleague games will count towards standings.
2. All Rules will follow Green Book rules.
3. There will be a continuous batting order which includes all rostered players.
4. Home team is responsible for keeping score and visiting team is responsible for pitch count and scoreboard operation.
5. Host team is responsible for providing both plate and base umpires.
6. LBLL fields – No new inning after 2:00 hours, if game scheduled after. If no game after, then no time limit but, game must end by 9:40, no new inning after 9:20.
7. Sunflower seeds are prohibited at the following fields: IRL, LNLL.
