



## **Interleague Playing Rules**

### **2019 LFL-IRLL: Majors**

#### **Majors Division Season Play**

The Majors Division is intended to be a logical transition from AAA to Intermediate Division. There will be a 46-foot pitching distance and 60-foot base distance. Players continue developing baseball fundamentals, all aspects of teamwork, and learn more advanced defense and offense strategy in this competitive division. Although competitive, the focus remains on player development with the emphasis always placed on having fun, player safety, and sportsmanship!

1. All games, including interleague games, will count towards standings.
2. All rules will follow Green Book rules.
3. There will be a continuous batting order which includes all rostered players.
4. If a game follows the majors game, then no new inning can start 15 minutes before the next game is scheduled to start.
5. The "dropped third strike" rule will be in play.
6. "15-Run Rule after 3 innings" is not being enforced and the "10-run rule after 4 innings" will be enforced.
7. No player shall sit out two consecutive innings.
8. Home team is responsible for keeping score and the visiting team is responsible for pitch count and scoreboard operation. Home team, regardless of field, is responsible for providing the umpires.
