Majors Division Season Play

The Majors Division is intended to be a logical transition from AAA to Intermediate Division. There will be a 46-foot pitching distance and 60-foot base distance. Players continue developing baseball fundamentals, all aspects of teamwork, and learn more advanced defense and offense strategy in this competitive division. Although competitive, the focus remains on player development with the emphasis always placed on having fun, player safety, and sportsmanship!

1. All games, including interleague games, will count towards standings.
2. All rules will follow Green Book rules.
3. There will be a continuous batting order which includes all rostered players.
4. No new inning shall start after 2 hrs and 15 min.
5. The "dropped third strike" rule will be in play.
6. "15-Run Rule after 3 innings" is not being enforced and the "10-run rule after 4 innings" will be enforced.
7. No player shall sit out 2 consecutive innings.
8. Home team is responsible for keeping score and the visiting team is responsible for pitch count and scoreboard operation.

Majors Division Post Season Play

- a) Single elimination tournament. placing is based on regular season record.
 - a. 1st place team plays 4th place team, 2nd place team plays 3rd place team, etc. The higher seeded team has the choice of being home team or visiting team.

b) 1st & 2nd place teams get trophies.
