Seniors Division Season Play

All players continue developing baseball fundamentals, all aspects of teamwork, and learn more advanced defense and offense strategy. The skills in this competitive division more closely follow “real baseball” rules, playing on a traditional field size with 60-foot 6-inch pitching distance and 90-foot base lengths. Although competitive, the focus remains on player development with the emphasis always placed on having fun, player safety, and sportsmanship!

This division is managed by District 55, and thus follows “Green Book” rules and District 55 provided local rules known as “South County Coalition Rules” provided by D55. The following is intended to provide clarity regarding games at Heroes Park to be followed by all teams, and additional administrative items that pertain only to LFL Seniors teams.

1. Field Maintenance:
 - a. The home team shall be responsible for field preparation. The field must be in playing condition at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the scheduled start time. The field must be dragged, watered (if necessary), and lines painted.
 - b. The visiting team shall be responsible for field take down and locking the bin.
 - c. All trash shall be cleared from the dugouts by both teams.
 - d. In the event that the home team or visiting team is not from LFL, the LFL team playing the game shall conduct the field duties assigned to both the home and visiting teams above.
2. Trophies will be provided by LFL at the end of the season.
3. No new innings after 9:30pm on Friday night games and drop dead at 9:50pm being played at Heroes Park.
4. Home team is responsible for keeping score and the visiting team is responsible for pitch count and scoreboard operation.

Seniors Division Post Season Play

- a) Best record wins the season. In the event of a tie, one (1) playoff game shall take place following regular season rules. Home team is determined by whichever team has scored the most runs throughout the regular season.
