HOW TO RESCHEDULE A REGULAR SEASON GAME

Process:

The commissioner of each division will be responsible for re-scheduling games.

The commissioner will:

1. Look at available field times and coordinate with each coach to find a date/time/field that will work for the make-up game.

Resource: Practice schedule – only available practice times can be used for make-up games. Make-up games take precedence over practice. At the end of the scheduled season, there should be a few open days for make-up games. Make-up games need to be made-up quickly to ensure enough time to complete all games before tournaments.

- 2. Notify the Umpire Director of new game information so an umpire can be arranged.
- 3. Update the schedule in SiPlay.
- 4. Communicate to the team whose practice will be replaced. Make new practice arrangements, if available.

To update the schedule in SiPlay:

You must be logged in AND be assigned by the League to edit game schedules. Commissioners will be assigned.

To edit a game/event:

- 1. Go to sevalley.com > Teams.
- 2. Select the Team you want to reschedule.
- 3. Select **Schedule** from the last side navigation.
- 4. Select **Calendar View** from the top navigation.
- 5. Select the game/event you want to edit.
- 6. Select Edit.
- 7. Update the game date and location.
- 8. Add a note in the Game Notes section for what the change is, i.e. Re-scheduled game from 4/10/2019 at Draper Park, Field 4.
- 9. Select Save.
