The Point Pleasant Soccer Club (PPSC) Parent's Code of Conduct has been established to clarify and define the standards of ethical and moral behavior expected of Parents affiliated with the PPSC.

- To teach your child to play within the spirit and intentions of the rules and to refrain from criticizing the game officials, coaches and players.
- To respect the Officials authority and decisions during the games.
- To never place the value of winning over the safety and welfare of the players.
- To support and respect PPSC coaches and teams.
- To not instruct from the sidelines and only provide positive cheering.
- To ensure that my child will attend all games and practices as possible and when not possible, to inform the coach in advance.
- To support a sports environment free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and refrain from their use at sporting events.

Code Compliance

The PPSC Executive Board will hold Parent's accountable for their actions and behavior. Violation of this Code of Conduct will be expediently addressed by the PPSC Executive Board thru a hearing process.
