

Point Pleasant Soccer Club Player's Code of Conduct

The Point Pleasant Soccer Club (PPSC) Player's Code of Conduct has been established so that Players recognize that they are part of a team and need to conduct themselves in such a manner that the principals, integrity, and dignity of the sport, club and team are not compromised.

As a Player in the PPSC club, the following is expected:

- To exhibit good sportsmanship and behavior at all times to player's, referees, coaches and fans of both teams.
- To play the game for the game's sake-for the fun of it.
- To treat your coach, teammates, and opponents with respect.
- Not to argue with or criticize the referee or linesperson.
- To avoid inappropriate behavior during practices, games, team or club sponsored events and/or tournaments.
- To control your emotions.
- To attend practices and games. If attendance is not possible attempts should be made to notify the Coach in advance.
- To attempt to win through your skill, effort and tactics; to be fair always, no matter what the cost.
- To take victory modestly and defeat graciously.
- To adhere to the laws of the game.
- To conform to the rules established by the PPSC.

The PPSC Executive Board will hold Player's accountable for their actions and behavior. Violation of this Code of Conduct will be expediently addressed by the PPSC Executive Board thru a hearing process.
