



KINO STADIUM/SOUTH FIELD COMPLEX

PLAYER/COACH INSTRUCTIONS

KINO STADIUM

- Parking for players and coaches scheduled to play in the stadium is in the lot on the west side of the stadium. Personnel are reminded to lock and secure their vehicles. Do not leave anything visible in the vehicle that can attract problems. The league and Pima County are not responsible for player, coach or spectator vehicle security.
- Field 3 (full size field) and Field 2 (1/2 infield), and open batting cage tunnels next to Field 3 are available to teams scheduled to play in the stadium to warm up prior to coming into the stadium. These facilities will be available to the teams 90 minutes prior to the gates opening at the stadium (6:00 PM). First come first serve on the facilities. Team coaches are to work together when it comes to the time length used at each location. The league will not be monitoring this aspect of the pre-game.
- 6:00 PM GATE C located on the west side of the stadium will be unlocked for team personnel to enter.
- Personnel (players and coaches) must be in full baseball uniform. There will be a security agent at the door and they will not permit anyone access unless they are in full uniform. Anybody wearing shorts or not in full uniform, will be not permitted access. The expectation and standard is that all team personnel will be professional looking once they enter the field. We do not want any sandlot look.
- Teams that have scorekeepers the are to enter through Gate B.
- Personnel will walk down the stairs and ramp out to behind home plate and then go to respective dugouts.
- Home team on the third base side and the Visiting team on the first base side.
- Team warm up once in the stadium shall occur in the outfield. There is no infield or outfield defensive warm up on the game field. No batting practice or soft toss permitted.
- Pitchers are to warm up in the bullpens prior to and during the game.
- Water jugs with cups will be in each dugout filled with water. If additional water or ice is needed during the game contact either 730-2506 or 297-7717 and the county event staff will be notified.
- Players are permitted to bring in as much water or power ade drink.
- No coolers of any size or kind permitted to be brought into the stadium.
- After the game is over teams are collect equipment, clean up the dugout and leave. Any team post game meeting to be held in the dugout not on the field. Teams will be given 5 minutes for the meeting. Event staff need to clean up and the light cost meter is running. Lights out in 15 minutes after the game has concluded.

KINO STADIUM

- Team personnel are to leave the stadium the way they came in through tunnel behind home plate and out Gate C.
- Players and coaches that are not playing a game in the stadium are welcomed to attend a game, but they must present their all access credential pass to security and the attendant at Gate B. Failure to present the pass will result in the individual paying the gate rate of \$5.00.
- Lightning/inclement weather that halts a game team personnel are to leave the dugout and go back behind home plate through the tunnel. The wait will be 30 minutes before a decision is rendered to either continue the game or halt it.
- AUTOGRAPHS: It is possible there will be new fans that will come to these games in the stadium. It is also possible that the players may be asked for an autograph by a young individual. We wish to stress that the player if so requested for an autograph is to take the time and provide the autograph.

KINO SOUTH FIELDS 4-5-6-7

- Parking for players and coaches that will play scheduled game at the South Field Complex is in the main public parking lot south of the stadium. There is covered parking spaces. First come first serve. Do not leave anything visible in the vehicle that can attract problems. The league and Pima County are not responsible for player, coach, or spectator vehicle security.
- Entrance to the south fields is through the gate located adjacent to the Administration building.
- Gate for players and coaches in full baseball uniform will be permitted access 90 minutes prior to game time (5:30PM). For the public access 1 hour prior to game time (6:00 PM).
- Players and coaches at minimum must be wearing team jersey when entering the complex. Individual not wearing at minimum the team jersey saying they are with the team will not be granted access and they will pay the gate rate of \$4.00.
- Players and coaches can bring in as much water and power ade drink as they wish.
- No outside coolers of any size or kind permitted. No team coolers permitted.
- Water jugs filled with water and cups will be made available in each dugout. Ice is available from concessions.
- If further water is needed during the game, players can take the water jugs directly to the concession facility and they can be filled.
- The batting cages are not available for use.
- The scheduled home team occupies the third base dugout. The visiting team occupies the first base dugout.
- NOT PERMITTED: batting practice. infield or outfield warm up on the game field. Players are to warm up in the outfield or on the side.
- Pitchers are to warm up prior to and during the game in the bullpens. Starting pitcher not permitted to warm up on the game mound prior to the game.
- After the game has been completed, players and coaches are responsible for cleaning up the dugout before they leave.

KINO SOUTH FIELDS 4-5-6-7

- Post- game team meeting is permitted. Max time is 5 minutes. Event staff needs to clean up and get the lights turned off. Lights will go out 15 minutes after the game has concluded.
- Lightning/inclement weather situations that require personnel to leave the field they go to the parking lot and wait minimum 30 minutes before a decision is rendered whether to resume or halt the game.
- Players and coaches that are not playing a game they are welcomed to attend, but they must present their all access credential pass to the event staff. Failure to present the pass shall result in the individual paying the gate rate of \$4.00.
