DLC 3 V 3 Tournament Format

**Teams will be assigned to play in divisions by age and gender.
The oldest team member will determine the division.**

3 Players On the Court - Recommend Teams of 4 or 5.

Divisions:

- Youth (Girls/Boys - 14 and Under - Parents welcome)
- Women's (All Ages)
- Co-Ed (High School and Above - At least one member of each gender on court at all times)
- Men's (15 and above - will be broken into 2 divisions to better manage time)
- All Abilities (Special needs players of all ages)

Teams must have a minimum of 3 players. Four-member team is highly recommended.

Each team will play a minimum of two games. The top teams will advance to playoffs. Prizes will be awarded to top finishing teams.

A “regular” game will be to 15 points or 12 minutes. Tournament directors reserve the right to adjust game lengths if deemed necessary to meet time constraints.

Teams will be assigned a number based on the order of receipt of registrations. The lowest number team will start each game with possession throughout the tournament and playoffs.

The tournament will run at a very fast pace so all players should know their schedules and report to their assigned court 15 minutes prior to their game start time.

Check-In:

- The week before the tournament team captains will be emailed with their division start times and must check in the teams with all members 30 minutes before division start time.
- Team captains are the only team members to receive tournament information by email and are responsible to pass along the information to their team members.
- Games will be “self-refereed”. The player with ball control is responsible to call any fouls
- Note that the Café with seating will be open throughout the day serving food, beverages, and snacks. Feel free to hang out here with friends.
- Games are to be played for fun with utmost level of sportsmanship in honor of Dominic!

Tournament Rules

- Regular games will be played to 15 points or 12 minutes.
- The lowest assigned number team will start with possession.
- Running clock. No time outs except for injury.
- Substitutions can only be made at dead ball times.
- In the event of a tie, play will continue with the starting possession determined by a coin toss. First team to score twice is the winner.
- All games played on a half-court.
- The defensive team must “check” the ball to start the game and all dead ball situations.
- The ball must be “taken back” completely over the check-in line after each change of possession, even if the ball does not touch the basket rim.
- No stalling allowed. Possession will be turned over after a warning by court monitor.
- If a foul is called, the ball will be retained by the fouled team and checked in to resume play.
- All baskets are worth 1 point. No “3” point line.
- All players must be registered on the team form with waiver signed. Replacement players can only be made at check-in time with waiver signed before division play begins.
- Players may only register on one team per division.
- The games will always begin at the assigned times. If a team does not have three players ready at the start, that team will be penalized 2 points for each minute they are late. A forfeit is declared after 5 minutes.
- Court monitors are assigned by the tournament. They will have final decision in any disputes and will keep the score.
- All participants must have proper (and clean) sneakers to enter on the court.
- No food, gum or beverages in the gym.
- Games are to be played for fun and highest level of sportsmanship in honor of Dominic.
