### **NOTICE OF ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING & WINTER REC COACHES MEETING**

The 2018 CLSF Annual Membership Meeting and Mandatory Winter Rec League Coaches Meeting will be held on Tuesday, February 20, 2018, at 7:00 P.M. at the West Elementary School (multi-purpose room) located at 100 Briarwood Rd. in Crystal Lake.

The purpose of the Rec Coaches' portion of the evening is to provide information for the upcoming Spring Session. *The head coach, an assistant coach, or other team representative is required to attend this meeting.* This meeting will be the only opportunity for coaches to submit special scheduling requests. No requests will be accepted after this meeting.

The agenda for the Annual Meeting will include the election of members to the CLSF Board of Directors. Directors serve a three-year term. Each Director is expected to attend monthly Board meetings, work his/her assigned shift at Soccerhouse during each season, and take on one of the specific director roles. Each year the Board elects its officers and assigns specific directorships for the other board members. Being a member of the CLSF Board of Directors is an

The Agenda will also include two proposed amendments to the CLSF By-Laws. See following notice.

### **NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CLSF BYLAWS**

At its January 15, 2018 regular monthly meeting, the CLSF Board of Director's adopted a resolution proposing the following 2 amendments to the CLSF Bylaws, and directed that the proposed amendments be submitted to a vote of the members at the Annual Meeting:

1. Section 5.01 of the Bylaws currently provides that the Board of Directors shall consist of a minimum of 9 and a maximum of 15 persons. The exact number of Directors shall be fixed or changed by the Board from time to time without further amendment of the Bylaws. **The proposed amendment would change the size of the Board to a minimum of 7 and a maximum of 13 persons.**

2. Section 5.01 of the Bylaws also currently does not impose term limits on Directors. **The proposed amendment would limit a person to serving no more than 2 consecutive full 3-year terms. After 2 years the person would again be eligible to serve as a Director.**

The Bylaws provide that a proposed amendment to the Bylaws may be adopted by the affirmative vote of three-fourths (¾) of the votes present and voted in person.
