



COVID 19 Mitigation Guidelines for Parents & Spectators

- Ensure your player is healthy and check your player's temperature before activities with others.
- Participants must not exhibit any signs or symptoms of the COVID-19 virus in the past 14 days and have no known exposure to someone who has been ill in 14 days. Any individual who has tested positive for the COVID 19 Virus or had close contact (15 min or more) with any other person who is diagnosed with COVID-19 may not participate in a CLSF activity for 14 days. This means no games or practice during the 14-day period.
- **Immediately notify CLSF at info@clsf.org if your player is diagnosed with the COVID 19 virus or has come into close contact with someone who has. To ensure confidentiality, do not notify your player's coach. CLSF will make the appropriate announcement to the team and other affected persons.**
- Ensure your player has a mask to wear. Players must now be masked when participating in a game or practice session. There are no exceptions. Masks must always cover the mouth and nose. Players who are not actively participating in a game or practice session, i.e., are on the sidelines, may remove their mask if they are able to maintain a social distance of at least 6 feet.
- The number of spectators attending each game or practice session will be limited to 50 persons. For this reason, we ask that spectators be limited to immediate household members or guardians of participants. Spectators must remain 30 feet from the playing field or practice area and 30 feet from any other group. At the Lippold Park Soccer Complex each field will have at least 1 area marked off and designated for this purpose.
- All spectators ages 2 and older must wear masks when entering the playing area. Once inside the designated spectator areas, face coverings should be worn if one is not able to maintain a social distance of at least 6 feet from others who are not members of the same family. This includes when walking to and from the playing fields to the parking area and/or restrooms.
- Masks are required of anyone who uses the restroom facilities at Soccerhouse. Restrooms will be cleaned regularly and sanitizer will be available. Parents are asked to assist in making sure these facilities are treated with respect.
- CLSF will monitor masking and social distancing by spectators.
- Consider not carpooling or very limited carpooling.
- Ensure player's clothing is washed after every practice and game. Ensure all player's equipment, (shoes, balls, shin guards, etc.) are sanitized after every practice and game. Ensure your player always has necessary sanitizing products with them.
- Do not assist your coach with equipment before or after practices and games.
- Notify your coach via the Team Website if you, or a family member plans to attend a practice session or game.
- Players and spectators should leave the field immediately following the conclusion of the game.
